

96 - sizeof Operator

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It is the only operator in C evaluated at compile time.

```
i = 1;  
sizeof (i++);
```

→ Will get skipped over since sizeof is evaluated at compile time.

So expressions inside sizeof get skipped.

printf(i); → o/p = 1.

sizeof Pointer :

(Pointer / Address)

```
int i;
```

```
printf(" %d ", sizeof (&i)); → o/p = 8
```

Size of any pointer is always 8.
